I hope both you and the children had a rested Easter break ready for what is possibly the busiest term in the school year for our Year 6 pupils.

Below is a reminder of the SATS timetable by day:

| Thursday 12 <sup>th</sup> May  | Reasoning (Paper 3) 40 minutes                                    |

Each morning, we will be opening up for our Year 6 pupils at 8.30am. We would encourage them to come into school for that time for a spot of breakfast and chance to prepare themselves ready for the day.

From Monday-Wednesday, we will be offering the children their choice of continental breakfast and sausage/bacon sandwich. On the Friday, children can still come in at 8.30am, but we will have a celebration breakfast of the children's choice. Following this, the children will have a celebratory morning, with activities the group will decide upon.

The SATS assessments will take place in the morning, with afternoons as normal. Children will sit the assessments either in the classroom or in the library, depending on their access arrangements.
